If you want to be absolutely confident before you apply for a job, you can ask yourself a series of questions that make up a job-specific self-analysis.

Similar to the list of recruiter requirements, a job-specific self-analysis should be combined with a genuine vacancy. Again, terms like “right” and “this company” are meaningless without context.

JOB-SPECIFIC

Personal Qualities

- Have I got the right experience?
- Have I got the proper training for this job?
- Do I have the right appearance?
- Does the job suit my domestic situation?
- Does the job suit my personality?

What are my goals?

- Do I want to stay with this company for a long time?
- Do I want to climb up in the hierarchy of this company?

Ethics?

- Do I want to be associated with this company?
- Do I agree with the company's mission statement?
- Do I agree with the company's policy?
- Do I agree with the work conditions and personnel policy?

Conclusion?

- Would I be happy in this job?
